## SCHOLARSHIPS

The Bio-Vert Green Action Fund awards \$500 scholarships to college or university students enrolled in an environmental program or actively involved in an environmental committee. Students supported by the Bio-Vert Green Action Fund must demonstrate an ability to initiate projects and to protect the environment through concrete actions.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Enrolled as a full-time student in a recognized college or university located in Québec
- Have not yet graduated
- Are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Have led a project or organized an event generating a tangible impact on environmental quality

### How to Apply

All scholarship applications must be submitted using the appropriate form and must contain the following information:

- Student's name and contact info
- Student's profile, academic path and reasons for his or her environmental studies or involvement
- Description of initiatives already involved in and/or project carried out, including
  - nature and scope of project
  - student's participation
  - impact on the community

Scholarship applications must also include a copy of the student's latest transcript and a letter of reference from a professor, faculty dean or other staff member of the college or university supervising the student's project. The letter of reference must describe the student's involvement in an environmental project.
